

MERIT-CUM-MEANS SCHOLARSHIP (MCM)

There is a provision for award of Merit-cum-Means Scholarship to a maximum of 25% of students admitted to B.Tech (H), B.Arch., 5-Year Dual Degree, 5-Year M.Sc. courses. The value of scholarship is Rs.1000/- per month with tuition fee waiver (through reimbursement). The criteria for such scholarship is – (i) **Merit consideration** : the student should have obtained at least 60% marks in aggregate or a grade corresponding to 60% marks in the qualifying examination for JEE and (ii) **Means consideration** : The gross annual income of a student's parent/guardian and his family from all sources in the preceding financial year (From 1st April 2010 to 31st March, 2011) must not exceed Rs.4,50,000/-. Also, those students who satisfy the specified 'Means Criterion' as stated but do not satisfy 'Merit Criterion', may be granted exemption from payment of tuition fee, subject to approval on merit of each case by the competent authority. The number of such tuition free students shall be restricted to 10% of the students admitted each year.

The downloaded application form duly filled in and signed by the student and parent/guardian, with all required documents has to be submitted to Academic (UG) Section latest by 30th August, 2011. Incomplete applications or applications submitted beyond the last date are liable to be rejected.

Therefore, students aspiring for MCM scholarship may bring for their interest the filled in application form along with all completed documents including the parent's/guardian's annual income certificate (as shown in the website) at the time of admission.
